

IAC 2024 MILAN - ISRAEL SPACE DELEGATION

The International Astronautical Congress in Milan was a landmark gathering, uniting space enthusiasts worldwide for the 75th time. With the theme "Responsible Space for Sustainability," IAC 2024 marked the largest IAC ever, bringing together a diverse community to shape a sustainable future in space.

Over 14,700 attendees from 120 countries participated in the event, where more than 530 companies showcased their innovations in the conference exhibition. Additionally, 4,160 presentations and panels provided insights into the future of space exploration and sustainability.



For the first time, we created an Israeli National Pavilion to serve as a hub for Israeli startups, researchers, and industry leaders to connect with the global space community, foster new partnerships in space exploration and commercialization. A unique art exhibition within the pavilion explored the intersection of space and creativity, with installations and multimedia works by Israeli artists reflecting on the human experience of space and its future potential.
